

How to Make your very own Laundry Soap



The Recipe:

- 1/3 bar Fels Naptha Soap or 1 whole bar of Ivory or homemade soap
- 1/2 cup Arm & Hammer Super Washing Soda
- 1/2 cup Borax powder
- 2+ gallon bucket and lid for storing.

If you find that you are allergic or have skin irritation from most laundry soap and heck, you just want to make it yourself, then here is a great recipe for you to try - and you can get it all at your one stop shop - Paul's ACE Hardware.



Instructions:

1. Grate your soap and place it in a sauce pan. Add 6 cups of water and heat until the soap melts
2. Add the Arm & Hammer Washing Soda and Borax and stir until it is dissolved.
3. Remove from heat.
4. Pour 4 cups of HOT water into your bucket. Add the soap mixture and stir.
5. Add another gallon and 6 cups of water and stir.
6. Store your laundry soap in your bucket, covered. Use 1/2 cup per load.
